## **Living Donation: Key Facts**<sup>5</sup>

- Living organ donation and transplantation can combat the critical shortage of deceased donors.
- ~1 in 4 living donors are not biologically related to the recipient.
- When a patient receives a living donor transplant, the gift of a kidney is given to the next person on the deceased donor wait list.

## **Deceased Kidney Donations**

3 to 5 years.3

10-15 years, on average.

Patient and graft survivals are significantly shorter in deceased kidney transplantation.7

Recipients must reach the hospital within 24 hours once contacted about an available kidney.

One organ donor = Maximum 2 kidney recipients.4
